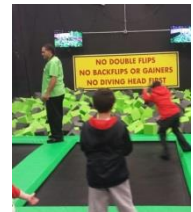
Other: Pack a lunch & drink (lunch can be purchased at the Golf Center at an additional cost).

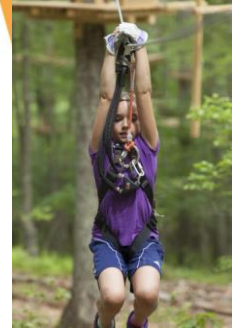

Date: Thursday, August 7th
Where: The Adventure Park
Cost: \$35 per child

Activities: There's nothing like a climb at The Adventure Park at Storrs where you will find this amazing "aerial forest park." **This trip is only for campers ages seven and above.** The park is a series of platforms in the trees connected by cable, wood, rope and zip lines to form bridges. Each bridge presents a different challenge of how to get to the next platform. A series of bridges form "aerial trails" throughout the forest. Relax, you don't have to be a circus acrobat or Tarzan! Choose from five different color-coded trails, from "beginner" (easier and lower to the ground) to intermediate, to advanced (the most challenging). Everyone will receive a complete safety orientation before our climb. The double-connected, "always-locked-on" climbing system helps keep the climbing harness securely attached to the safety line at all times. Bus transportation will be provided.

Other: Pack a lunch & drink. Sunscreen & bug spray??

Where: Brownstone Park

Activities: The Brownstone Exploration & Discovery Park is a dynamic former quarry featuring swimming, hiking, cliff jumping (from as low as 5 feet), zip lines, waterslide, rope swing, and inflatable obstacle courses in the water. Bus transportation will be provided.

Other: Pack a lunch, snack, & plenty to drink. Towels & dry clothes can be brought. Water shoes are helpful but not required. Do not bring any valuables or money. Do not wear watches, jewelry, etc... that can be lost in the water.
